The goal of this project is to develop a premium hotel booking portal for luxury travelers, with real-time hotel data from global APIs. The platform will serve as a one-stop destination for discovering and booking luxury hotels, resorts, and villas worldwide.

The portal will handle search, filtering, booking, payments, and API-triggered backend confirmations, ensuring both elegance and functionality.

2. Website Functional Modules (User Flow)

2.1 Home Page & Brand Experience

- Luxury-themed interface with a visually rich design (white space, HD banners, clean fonts)
- Hero section with search bar (destination, dates, rooms, guests)
- Featured destinations: curated hotel collections (e.g., "Top Picks in Maldives", "Beach Villas in Bali")
- Promotional blocks (discounts, deals, limited-time offers)
- Footer with support, FAQs, About, and Terms & Conditions

2.2 Location Search Experience

- Search box where users can type:
 - Country
 - City
 - Island or landmark
- Auto-suggestions via Google Places API
- Manual location entry enabled for custom geographies
- Geo-tagged hotel results from partner APIs (filtered by user query)

2.3 Hotel Listings Page (Search Results)

Real-time results fetched from hotel booking APIs





- List of matching hotels displayed with:
 - o Hotel name, image, star rating, location, starting price, and short intro
 - Real-time room availability badges (API-based)
- Filters and Sort options:
 - Star rating
 - Facilities (pool, spa, breakfast included, etc.)
 - Price range
 - Property type (resort, villa, hotel, boutique stay)
 - Guest rating
 - Distance from center/landmark
- Sorting by: Price (Low to High), Top Rated, Most Booked, New

2.4 Hotel Detail Page

- Full page for selected hotel showing:
 - Hotel photos (image carousel or gallery)
 - Star rating, location (map view), and hotel contact (from API)
 - Description, room types, amenities, room features
 - Availability calendar for selected dates
 - Room prices (daily rate, discounted rate)
 - Cancellation policy, taxes, and additional fees
 - Reviews from source API (if supported)
 - Book Now button tied to selected room

2.5 Booking Workflow

- 1. User selects room and number of guests
- 2. Clicks Book Now
- 3. Directed to Booking Summary Page showing:
 - Room info, dates, price breakup
 - Guest details form: name, email, phone, special requests
- 4. Terms & Conditions checkbox





5. Click Proceed to Payment

2.6 Payment Gateway Integration

- Integrated payment gateway (Razorpay, Stripe, or PayPal)
- Secure checkout using hosted or embedded form
- Booking locked only after successful payment
- Payment captured by portal owner
- After successful payment:
 - Booking details stored in DB
 - API request sent to root hotel API to place booking at cost price
 - API response returns a booking reference ID

2.7 Confirmation Page & Email

- User sees confirmation message with booking ID
- Receives an automated branded HTML email including:
 - Hotel Name and Address
 - o Room type, dates, guest info
 - Total price paid and payment breakdown
 - Cancellation policy (if applicable)
 - Booking ID (portal-generated + API reference)
 - QR code or print option (optional)

2.8 Customer Account (Optional for Registered Users)

- View active/past bookings
- Cancel eligible bookings
- Download invoice
- Wishlist hotels (saved list)
- Update personal info

2.9 Booking for Someone Else

- While booking, user can:
 - Enter guest name separately





- Choose a manual location even if not in their current area
- Search and book luxury stays for friends, clients, or family members

GDPR Compliance:

To make the website GDPR-compliant, client will have to add following points in website.:

1. Privacy Policy & Legal Pages

- A detailed Privacy Policy explaining how user data is collected, stored, and processed.
- Terms & Conditions outlining user rights and obligations.
- A Cookie Policy describing how cookies are used on the site.

2. User Consent & Data Control

- Cookie Consent Banner allowing users to accept, reject, or customize cookies.
- Explicit Consent for Data Collection (e.g., checkboxes in forms, not pre-checked).
- User Data Control Panel where users can:
 - View their data.
 - Request data deletion.
 - Request a copy of their data (Data Portability).
 - Withdraw consent for data usage.

3. Data Security Measures

- Encrypt sensitive data (SSL/TLS for website security).
- Secure user authentication (e.g., hashed passwords).
- Data breach notification system to inform users of any data breaches.

4. GDPR-Compliant Data Processing

- Ensure third-party services (e.g., Google Analytics, payment gateways) comply with GDPR.
- Keep records of user consent (time, date, and method of consent).

- Real-time pricing calculated dynamically on frontend

- Edit branded email templates
- Set up booking alert emails to admin/user
- Configure SMTP, email footer, reply-to, etc.

Report Name	Description
Total Revenue (Date Range)	Shows the gross revenue collected from bookings for any selected time frame (Today, This Week, Last 30 Days, Custom Range).
Total Cost to Portal (Date Range)	API-level cost price for all booked hotels (auto-fetched from API responses or internal booking logs).
Profit & Loss Report (P&L)	Revenue – Cost = Net Profit per booking. Can be filtered by destination, hotel, date, or room type.
Commission/Markup Report	Shows the actual markup applied per booking and revenue earned per city, hotel type, or hotel name.

Booking Analytics

Report Name	Description
Total Bookings (All time / Date Range)	Full count of successful confirmed bookings made through the portal.





Cancelled Bookings	Lists all canceled bookings with reasons (API failed / User cancel / Payment issue).
Upcoming Bookings	Displays all upcoming check-ins organized by date, city, or hotel. Useful for planning support.

Customer Analytics

Report Name	Description
Top Booking Countries	Which countries users are booking for most often. Helps in targeting ads.
Top Cities / Hotels by Booking Volume	Find out which hotels or cities are most frequently booked.

Export & Sharing Options

- Export all reports in CSV, Excel, PDF
- Schedule email reports weekly or monthly
- Access visual graphs & trends on dashboard
- Download invoices per booking (PDF with tax if needed)
